



Career Based Intervention (CBI)

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The Career Based Intervention (CBI) program is an Ohio Department of Education Career-Technical Education program designed for high school students, who are identified as disadvantaged (either academically, economically, or both) and/or students with disabilities, who have barriers to achieving academic and career success. The program is designed to help students improve academic competency, develop professional skills, and implement a career plan that will serve them on the path to graduation and beyond. The CBI program utilizes a combination of in-class educational and on-site experiential learning opportunities to maximize student success. CBI is an intervention program, not a complete career field pathway. It emphasizes early awareness and recovery; students should not have the intention of remaining in the program throughout high school. The goal of the CBI program is to assist and prepare students for successful high school graduation, additional career-technical education and training, postsecondary education, and/or a meaningful career.

Uniform details:

Apollo students wear uniforms as part of the professionalism component of their career technical program. Wearing a uniform is meant to simulate real world work experiences as well as serve as a safety precaution. Uniforms are ordered from Cappies Sportswear through the Apollo website. All students who were accepted prior to the first day of school are expected to be in uniform by September 14th. Students accepted within the first two weeks of school must be in uniform by October 1st. Students who are not in uniform by these deadlines may be sent home or have daily grade reductions for professionalism.

FAQ for CBI

What are the requirements to get into CBI?

You must have a paid work experience with a minimum of 15 hours per week or volunteer at least 15 hours per week at a non-profit organization (Mercy Health, Habitat Restore, Humane Society, Goodwill, etc.) by the first day of school. There are no required classes or number of credits. Reliable transportation is required. This means your own transportation (car, drivers license).

What happens if I get fired?

If you get fired from your work experience, then you will receive a failing grade for the marking period. You will have two weeks to secure another work experience. After the two weeks, if no job has been obtained, then you will be required to stay at school every day for the full school day (until 2:25).

What if I stop going to my volunteer experience or am asked not to come back?

If your volunteer position stops without permission from the instructor, then you will receive a failing grade for the marking period. You will have two weeks to secure another paid or unpaid experience. After the two weeks, if no job has been obtained, then you will be required to stay at school every day for the full school day (until 2:25).

What happens if I want to quit my job?

You must get approval from the instructor first. If you do not get approval, then you will receive a failing grade for the marking period. We will discuss the pros and cons of the jobs and what are the reasons for quitting. Make sure you have another job secured before quitting the first position. Also, make sure you leave the first job appropriately by giving a two-week notice.

Can I switch work experiences during the year?

You must get approval from the instructor first. If you do not get approval, then you will receive a failing grade for the marking period. We will discuss the pros and cons of the jobs and what are the reasons for the switch. Make sure you have another job secured before quitting the first position. Also, make sure you leave the first job appropriately by giving a two-week notice.

What are the fees for the program?

The fees for CBI are the activity fees (\$35) plus any uniform shirts you order.

What is the uniform for CBI class?

The uniform consists of a CBI shirt and blue/black jeans. Shirt orders are through Cappi's and from the required website. Uniforms will be delivered to the school when they are ready. Orders for additional shirts can be taken anytime during the year. Jeans and shoes must meet the requirements of the school dress code. Jeans are not allowed to have holes or frays.

What is a typical day like?

School starts at 8:00. You will go to your four required classes (Related, Math, English, and Government or Science). Then you will be able to leave school at 11:11. You may stay to eat lunch and then leave. If you are behind on credits to graduate, the counselors may give you a fifth class. Then you will be dismissed at 11:58. Here again, you may stay and eat lunch. Since you are dismissed early and no buses run at that time, you must have reliable transportation to and from school and your work.

What do I do for weather delays and cancellations?

- If your home school delays for weather related reasons, then you are delayed for the same amount of time before reporting to Apollo.
- If your home school cancels for weather related reasons, then you are cancelled. You are still required to work if you are scheduled, or make other arrangements with your employer.
- If Apollo delays, then you are delayed for the same amount of time before reporting to school. You will not be dismissed until 11:45, so your day is extended. If you have to work before 11:45, then you will be dismissed at a time allowing you to make it to work. We will have a shortened class schedule.
- If Apollo cancels, then you are cancelled. You are still required to work if scheduled, or make other arrangements with your employer.
- If your home school is delayed for non-weather related reasons, you should report to school as normal at 8:00, as you follow Apollo's school calendar.
- For holiday breaks, you should follow Apollo's schedule, not your home school's schedule.

What if I am behind on credits to graduate?

If you are behind on credits for graduation, then you will be given Credit Recovery (GradPoint). This is an online course, and it will not start until about the beginning of October. It will need to be finished by the first part of May for seniors and mid-May for juniors and sophomores. It can be worked on wherever you can connect to the Internet. There will be class time available but not enough time to finish. Please make arrangements with me if you want to stay after your allotted time and work in the afternoon.

What if I am not doing well in any of my present classes (failing grades, missing assignments, etc.)?

If you are not doing well, please make arrangements with me for you to stay after your allotted time and work in the afternoon.
