

Students learn skills to keep buildings and facilities operational. Students train in the skilled areas of electrical maintenance and repair, plumbing maintenance and repair and then get their hands-on experience by training in drywall, basic carpentry, basic masonry, painting, and maintenance. This two-year program then prepares students for careers in the building industry where they can practice as a plumber's assistant, electrical assistant, carpenter's assistant and more.
