Apollo Career Center desires to hire qualified individuals as high school substitute teachers in academic and trade areas. Positions are for full- or half-days on an as-needed basis (\$125 per full day). Applicants must have, or have the ability to obtain, a substitute teaching license. Ohio offers various substitute teaching license including a 1-Year Temporary Non-Bachelor's Substitute Teaching License for applicants who do not hold a post-secondary degree. Applicants will need to submit:

1. Completed Apollo application.

2. Copy of substitute teaching license.
3. Copies of BCI and FBI background checks that are less than 1 year old.
(If needed, Apollo's Adult Education office completes background checks on a walk-in basis for anyone, Monday-Thursday, 8 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. The cost is \$35 each for BCI & FBI.)
