



Cell Phone Policy 2026-27

Personal electronic devices are not allowed at Apollo Career Center during the school day. Electronic devices include but are not limited to: cell phones, tablets, laptops, chromebooks, smart watches, headphones, earbuds, electronic glasses, etc. Only Apollo issued devices are allowed. All personal electronic devices must be off and in your locker prior to 7:50 am (warning bell) through 2:25 pm.

Consequences for each electronic devices violation:

- 1st:** Student turns in device(s) immediately
Student picks up device(s) at the last bell
An after-school detention is issued
- 2nd:** Student turns in device(s) immediately
Student turns in device(s) for five consecutive days before 1st period
A T-school is issued
- 3rd:** Student turns in device(s) immediately
Parent/guardian picks the device(s) up at their convenience
Student turns in device(s) for five consecutive days before 1st period
and a T-school is issued
- 4th:** Student turns in device(s) immediately
Parent/guardian picks the device(s) up at their convenience
Student turns in device(s) for five consecutive days before 1st period
Three (3) days In School Remediation (ISR) is issued
- 5th+):** Student turns in device(s) immediately
Parent/guardian picks the device(s) up at their convenience
Student turns in device(s) for five consecutive days before 1st period
Three (3) days Out of School Suspension (OSS) are issued

***Administration reserves the right to implement alternative plans when necessary**

*Ohio law requires all public K-12 schools to ban the personal use of cell phones during the instructional day, **which includes class time, lunch, recess, and passing periods. Districts were mandated to adopt this policy by January 1, 2026***
